WARM, HUMID WEATHER IS CONTINUING OVER NEBRASKA AND SOUTH DAKOTA, WITH EARLY MORNING FOG REPORTED AT MANY SOUTH DAKOTA POINTS. A COOL FRONT STRETCHES ACROSS NORTH DAKOTA AND MONTANA, AND THE FRONT WILL BE CAUSING THUNDERSHOWERS OVER MUCH OF THE REGION TODAY AND TONIGHT.

THERE WERE EARLY MORNING THUNDERSHOWERS AT DICKINSON, NORTH DAKOTA, AND GLASGOW, MONTANA. GLASGOW RECEIVED ABOUT A HALF INCH OF RAIN OVERNIGHT. THERE WERE THUNDERSHOWERS YESTERDAY AFTERNOON AND EVENING OVER WYOMING, BUT ONLY LIGHT AMOUNTS OF PRECIPITATION WERE RECORDED AT THE REGULAR REPORTING STATIONS.
