Universal Login for all Library Services

Rapid City, SD – Feb 17th, 2011 –The Rapid City Public Library is excited to announce that utilizing library services just got easier. Starting Feb 22nd, the same login that you use to access your library account will also be used to access our online research tools, services and computers.

Don't have a password for your library account yet? You can easily set one up by going to the Rapid City Public Library website (www.rapidcitylibrary.org), click on the "My Account" link and follow the these three simple steps:

1. Type your library card number into the first box.
2. Leave the second box (password) blank and hit *Enter*.
3. When prompted, add your new password. It should be more than six characters long and include at least one number and one letter.

Now that you have your new password, don't forget it! It will be the one you use to access your account to place holds, check requests, and use our online research tools and login into library computers.
